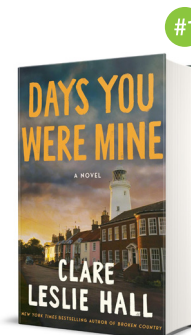
The Eleventh Hour

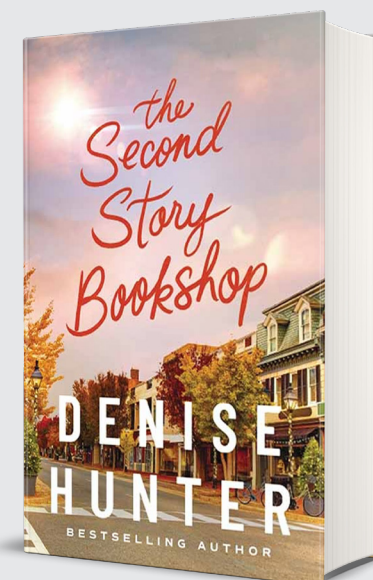
The Second Story Bookshop
