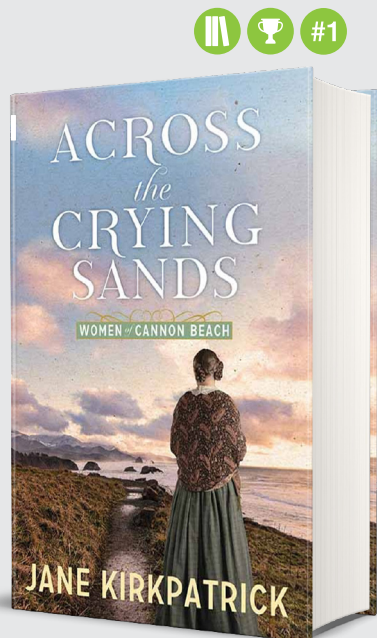
### Had to be You
