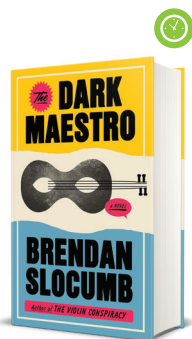
My Name Is Emilia del Valle

His searing portrayals on film ranged from an Iraq-based army bomb technician in *The Hurt Locker* before he became heir to the Jason Bourne franchise. Among other iconic roles, he also captured hearts as fan-favourite comic book marksman Hawkeye in seven Marvel films.
