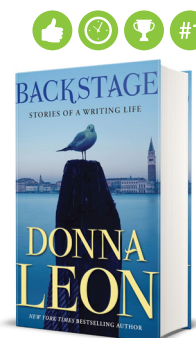
Anthony Hopkins

We Did OK, Kid is the raw and passionate memoir from a brilliant actor who has inspired audiences by his remarkable performances for more than 60 years.

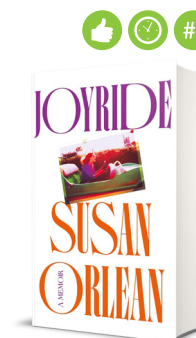

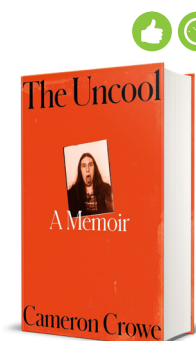

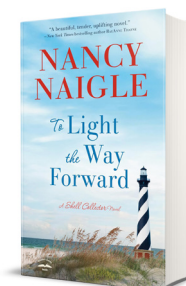
Everything's Coming Up Rosie
