When a strange man begins lurking around the school, this group of women must finally face the full repercussions of the big little truths they have and haven't shared with their kids.

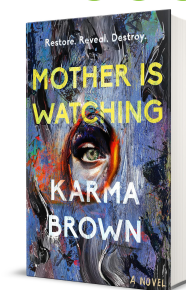

Nović asks us to recognise difference as a source of opportunity rather than fear, as a chance to draw families and communities together, and to build something new.

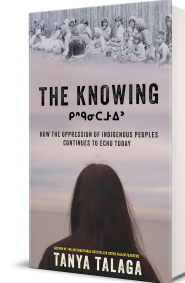
