Harlow Donne has sacrificed his life to the study of the classical world. So when he is invited to Oxford University to work on an obscure collection of papyrus fragments, he leaves his daughter and wife behind in Canada. In the Bodleian Library he unearths an obscure poem he calls the *Psoad*, a little known account of the Trojan War and a glimpse into the founding of Western civilisation itself, written by a commoner identified only as *Psoas*, the son of nobody.

Daughter. Prisoner. Survivor. Warrior. Nobody's Girl. This is Virginia Roberts Giuffre's last word.

In 2011, Virginia Roberts Giuffre hit the headlines as Jeffrey Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell's most outspoken victim – the woman whose decision to speak out helped send both serial abusers to prison and whose photograph with Prince Andrew catalysed his fall from grace. This is the powerful story of an ordinary girl who would grow up to confront adversity and trauma of the darkest form, yet found the strength to move forwards, reclaim her voice and shine a light on evil.
