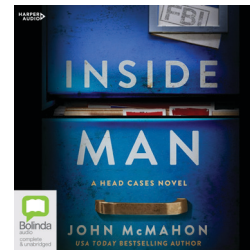
It is February and the Scottish Highlands village of Lochdubh is dealing with heavy snow and freezing temperatures.

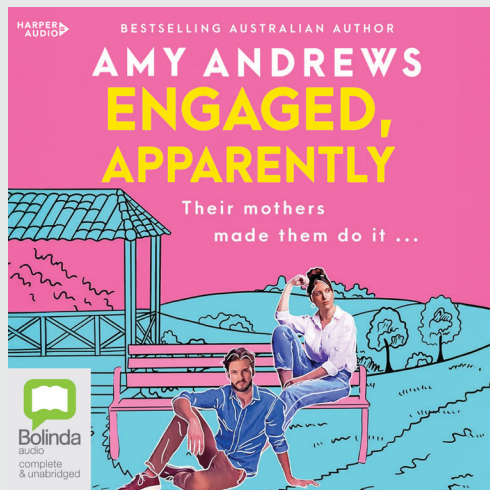
Departure(s) is a work of fiction – but that doesn't mean it's not true.
