She has won three BAFTAs (including the BAFTA Fellowship), an International Emmy Award, a British Comedy Award, a Rose d'Or Light Entertainment Festival Award, two Writers' Guild of Great Britain Awards, and a People's Choice Award. Saunders is perhaps best known for writing and playing the character Edina Monsoon in her sitcom *Absolutely Fabulous*, which ran for five full series, two telemovies, three special episodes, and a feature film over the course of twenty-four years from 1992 to 2016.
