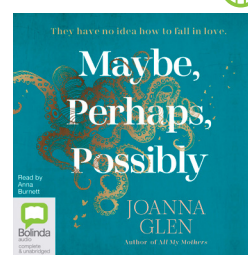
Lula Dean's Little Library of Banned Books
