In recent years the word 'trauma' has become ubiquitous. Yet it remains widely misunderstood. In Trauma Proof international expert Benjamin Perks redefines how we see childhood trauma, and outlines a new path towards healing and prevention.

Julia Roberts is one of America's most famous actors. After an early breakthrough with appearances in *Mystic Pizza* (1988) and *Steel Magnolias* (1989), Roberts rose to major fame when she headlined the top-grossing romantic comedy *Pretty Woman* (1990). Richard Wayne Van Dyke (born December 13, 1925) is an American actor, entertainer and comedian. His work spans screen and stage, and his accolades include a Golden Globe Award, a Tony Award and six Emmy Awards. Inducted into the Television Hall of Fame in 1995 and the Hollywood Walk of Fame in 1993, he was also honoured with the Screen Actors Guild Life Achievement Award in 2013, the Kennedy Center Honors in 2020 and was recognised as a Disney Legend in 1998. Some of his biggest credits include starring in *The Dick Van Dyke Show* from 1961 to 1966 and the movie musicals *Bye Bye Birdie* (1963), *Mary Poppins* (1964) and *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang* (1968).

Dick has narrated his own autobiography *My Lucky Life in and out of Show Business*, featured on page 29.

Mathew Baynton

Mathew Baynton is an award-winning British actor, writer and producer. He is well known for the highly celebrated sitcom *Ghosts*, which ran for five seasons. Mathew co-created, wrote and starred in the series alongside the creative collective Them There, who met on *Horrible Histories* and went on to collaborate on *Yonderland* and the feature film *Bill*.
